Library Cards

Hudson Library cards are free to any resident of the state of Ohio. Identification with current address is required before the card will be issued.

Children under the age of 14 will need a parent to co-sign the application and present address confirmation.



The library issues patrons a *Clevnet Greater Access* card which allows access to 30 libraries in Northeast Ohio. A \$2.00 charge is assessed for a lost or damaged library card.

Patrons are asked to have their library cards for all transactions.

There is a limit of 100 items that may be borrowed at one time.

A patron's borrowing privileges will be suspended when the amount of unpaid fines reaches \$25.00 or there are twenty or more overdue items on their card.

Parental

Due to the potentially mature content and theme of certain movies, patrons under the age of 18 will need signed parental/guardian permission to borrow videos and DVDs. Permission forms are available at the circulation desk. Parental/guardian permission is also required for those under the age 18 wishing to access the internet.

Renewal Policy

Ways to renew library materials

In person:

Bring to the library one of the following: the item to be renewed, your library card or the check-out receipt.

Online:

Visit www.hudsonlibrary.org and click on "check my account." Follow the directions under your account information.

If the item is past the due date, it cannot be renewed online.

By phone:

Call the library at 330-653-6658 and speak with the circulation dept. Have your library card handy.

All Hudson materials may be renewed one time. Items will renew for their normal circulation period. Hudson "Hot Pick" items cannot be renewed.

Items owned by other libraries and brought to Hudson through interlibrary loan will renew at the discretion of the owning library.
