# HUDSON LIBRARY

## Library Education Scholarship

The Friends of the Hudson Library, Inc. offers scholarships in Library and Information Science to residents of Hudson and the contiguous area as well as non-resident employees of The Hudson Library and Historical Society.

- PURPOSE:** To encourage careers in librarianship by providing financial assistance to pursue a graduate degree in library science.
- SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:** The Library Education Scholarship gives grants which do not require repayment. The amount of the grant in any one 12-month period beginning on April 1 shall be \$1,500 per calendar year.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Any person living in the Hudson area for at least one year prior to application, or any employee of The Hudson Library and Historical Society for at least one year prior to application, who intends to further his/her education in the field of library science from an ALA-accredited school.
- PROCEDURE:** Applicants must submit:
- 1) A scholarship application, available at the circulation desk of The Hudson Library or by mail from the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee or on-line at the Friends' page at [www.hudsonlibrary.org](http://www.hudsonlibrary.org)
  - 2) Transcripts of undergraduate and graduate study.
  - 3) List of references.

Scholarships will be available once a year as determined by the Committee. All applications must be received by March 1 for the 12-month period beginning April 1. Upon receipt of all applications, a committee comprised of a Chairman, the President of the Friends of The Hudson Library, the Director of The Hudson Library, one additional member of the Friends and one public representative will evaluate the merits of the applicants. Interviews with candidates may be scheduled as needed by the Scholarship Committee.

- AWARDING THE GRANT:** It is intended that the recipient of the Scholarship grant be notified by the Friends of The Hudson Library no later than April 1. A check in the amount approved will be made payable to the ALA-accredited school. Grants may be repeated to the same recipient over the period of their enrollment in library school.

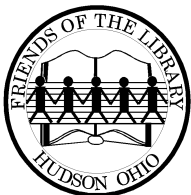
