Open to the public Monday through Sunday the Café is a relaxing area available to guests of the Library. Used for everything from business interviews, book club discussions, visiting with a friend, to a place for mothers and tots to mingle after Story Hour, the Café is there for your pleasure. It is a great place to leaf through a magazine while having a cup of hot chocolate in the winter or a room with access to a lovely outdoor eating area in warmer weather.

The conveniences offered are WIFI connection, debit and credit card privileges as well as a selection of food and drink choices to enjoy. The drink menu offers coffee (including a "Flavor of the Day"), hot tea, lattes, mochas, cappuccinos, espressos, iced tea, soft drinks and bottled water. To start your day there is a selection of cereal cups, bagels and muffins. Snacks include cookies, chips, pretzels, candy bars, yogurt, energy bars and fruit cups. You are welcome to bring in your own food and drink and eat in the Café.

In 2015 The Friends of the Hudson Library granted the funds for the Café to purchase a microwave and toaster. At the January 2016 meeting the Friends Board voted to grant the Library a monthly contribution to be used toward the purchase of food items for the Café.
