	For PLF, received a little over \$125K, 17% more than 2020; 30% more than estimate. Original estimate was similar to 2020, so we never really saw drop in estimate, just collected more. State revenues were consistently more than what the State thought. Carryover is due to Administration being very conservative with uncertainty of the levy and the economy. Balance is almost \$2.9 million, which will be helpful since the levy was not an increase.
	Investment account book is under \$2.6 million. Value is over \$3 million. Legacy has been with us for about a year. Molly will schedule them to come to the February Finance Committee and to the April Board Meeting. Committee gave Molly permission to discuss investing the capital funds in another vehicle since the CD return is so poor.  Giving Tuesday donations were received, as well as donation from the Sepe Family Fund.
